



Now, to respond to my question at the beginning, my desire will be this:





#### FCMM from 2004-2009


(From St Denis to Saint Thomas-Apôtre)

These were very challenging years for the FCMM community. As it strived to continue to grow and become a more stable community the atmosphere in our parish of residence was getting more and more antagonistic and restrictive. Gradually more and more facilities were not made available to us thus forcing us to stop many of our pastoral activities. Many did not anymore feel at home and happy. The attendance at our liturgical and pastoral activities started to be affected. Even the patient efforts of the Episcopal Vicar of the Region, Msgr Pierre Cote, trying to help the two communities come to a peaceful relationship ultimately failed. It became gradually apparent that the hosting community was determined to put the Filipino community out. The situation worsened as the months went on.

In the meantime the FCMM community tried to survive and to continue the various activities of the different pastoral ministries despite the many constraints. With patience and endurance the community strived to achieve some objectives. Among the big memorable events that happened during the years 2004-2006 are: the launching of the first Miss FCMM competition, the communal renewal of Marriage Vows with seven couples participating, the 15th Anniversary Variety Show, the creation of the first Ethnic K of C Council, the Notre-Dame-des-Philippines Council 13585, the Search for the King and Queen of Angels, the



The Feast of Sn Lorenzo Ruiz Procession on Laurier Avenue.



formulation of the FCMM's Mission-Vision, and finally the acquisition and transfer to Saint Thomas-Apôtre Church at blvd Saint-Laurent,

The sojourn at the Saint Denis parish unfortunately came to a sad end when the new parish priest brought to reality the dream of the hosting community to get rid of the FCMM community. Just a few weeks after his arrival the priest went to see Msgr Michel Parent, the Episcopal Vicar of the Cultural Communities, in order to inform him that he, the cure, was going to send the Filipinos out of his parish. The bad news was then transmitted to Fr. Frank Alvarez,pme. the FCMM's pastor.

This was the most painful moment for the FCMM community. Given only one month to find another place, a mixture of tension, stress and disperation became a shared experience for everyone in the community. The only source of hope was the assurance and the relentless effort of Msgr Parent to help find another place. With the consent of Cardinal Turcotte he proceeded to find ways to solve the crisis. The grace of God led him to talk to Msgr Pierre Blanchard, Episcopal Vicar of Region Nord. Having been a former Episcopal Vicar of the Cultural Communities he already knew many of our needs. He at once informed Msgr Parent that this Church of Saint Thomas-Apôtre was up for sale. Thus after several meetings and negotiations between the

FCMM and the Fabrique of St Thomas-Apôtre as well as the two Episcopal Vicars concerned it was finally agreed and decided that the Church, the Presbyter and the parish grounds would be sold to the FCMM.

With this historic event a new day has dawned in the life of the FCMM community. There was great rejoicing, excitement and gratitude to God and to the Diocese. The drooping spirit of the community became revitalized again and filled with dynamism. Finally on October 22/06 the official take over of the parish facilities took place. During the fully-packed attended Mass the welcome and friendly reception was led by the Cure of the St Thomas-Apôtre Fabrique, Fr. Serge Laverdure, CSSR. In response Fr. Frank Alvarez, PME, the FCMM's Pastor, expressed the community's heartfelt gratitude to the Fabrique members for their warm welcome as well as for their openness and willingness to pass on their Church to the FCMM. As part of the agreement the French community would be able to continue to celebrate their Liturgical services in the Church and to avail of its facilities for free.

The first two months in the new home was a time of clean up, renovations and repairs especially in the Presbyter, and adjustment to the new responsibilities and concerns. But everything was made light by the amazing community spirit

in terms of cooperation and collaboration, in terms of sharing time, talents and treasure and expertise. Happy and greatly inspired by the acquisition of a new home everybody was eager to come after their work in the afternoon and share their services up till late in the evening. With all these different contributions from the many volunteers everything was soon ready for the resumption of regular activities.

Strengthened with a renewed spirit and feeling at ease with the new home the community was now willing to attain more growth in the knowledge and practice of the Faith. The Evangelization and Bible seminars have been intensified, the Liturgical life has been constantly updated and made more dynamic, and the other Pastoral Ministries for the Youth, the Family Life, the Sick, and Prayer Groups have embarked on new projects. The two religious organizations, i.e. the Legion of Mary and the Knights of Columbus, became even more involved and committed in their respective domains. The K of C 4th Degree members have increased to the point that the San Lorenzo Ruiz Assembly was created to be the First Filipino 4th Degree Assembly in the entire Canada. All these to say that with the possession of the new mission home also came a new momentum and new breath. And in turn this enabled the community to take on a daring project, and that is the renovation of the Church.

For all these it is but fitting and proper indeed that, especially on this occasion of our 20th Anniversary of Canonical Installation, we magnify the Lord for all the wonders He has wrought to our FCMM community, and through us to those who have journeyed with us in one way or another.

#### FR. GERARD LOISELLE, PME

(Homily on Simbanggabi Dec. 18, 2008)

"Towards a Deeper Life in God's Love."

"Seeking ever new ways to reach out in Love: A People of Charity and Justice!"

Where will I get this way to love God better? First of all, how can I imagine my love for God? Where will I meet him?



Those are the questions we will try to answer tonight. The more we discover God, the more we know him, the more we will try to love him.

In my personal life, I can say that I am a Christian. So I am a member of a community, like you are, each one of you. You belong to this community named the Filipino Mission. When we belong to a community, we try to follow the spirit of this community, we try to take the orientation preached by the community.

I am sure you are guided by what Jesus himself told us to do: "Love God and love your neighbors." So our orientation is Love. We have the best proof that God our Father loves us. He sent his own Son 2, 000 yrs. ago. Jesus came with a message: He wants to tell us that his Father, who is our Father too, loves us. He would like that we receive his Son Jesus as a brother because he has the power to give us the means and the ways to practice justice and love.

Where will we find Jesus, or where do we see his presence, if he is indeed among us?

Your faith and the faith of your Parish Priest, Administrators and the Parish Council helped you to acquire this Temple, this building where you can come and pray, talk with Jesus. Here you will find Him. Here, He is present in the Word of God which is proclaimed at every Mass. Here, He is present under the appearance of Bread and Wine and becomes present in us when we receive him in Holy Communion. And here, He is present in the person of your many brothers and sisters who, like you, come to seek him. The fact that this Church now belongs to you – you should be at ease to come and visit Jesus.

I have seen the beginnings of your parish- the Filipino Mission. I worked with Fr. Gosioco to group together the Filipinos leaving in Montreal and the surroundings. You gave your collaboration, even if you had difficulties. You succeeded with Cardinal Gregoire in getting the recognition of your Filipino Mission. And you succeeded with Cardinal Turcotte in giving you your own church building. I know you are proud to attend your gatherings, to receive the Sacraments in your own church where you can speak and sing in your own language. You now have the place to keep your traditions alive . But remember also, in this Church building, you must keep in mind the need to encounter Jesus.

We are celebrating Christmas not in Palestine but here in your Church. Jesus is here and He will stay with us up to the end of time. My dear people, you have so many chances to meet Jesus. Your community is united by love and the more you can practice justice and work together, the more this love will grow stronger. The more that people will see that you encounter Jesus in this community, in this Church.

Continue to give your cooperation to Fr. Frank and your Parish Council, because they will help you meet Jesus in your neighbours among you. Rule over your problems and differences and get more courage from each other. You will also then be examples of justice and charity to all.

#### 20 YEARS OF GROWTH AND PROGRESS

I have known the Filipino Catholic Mission of Montreal 10 years ago, on January, 2000. Since we are celebrating its 20 Anniversary of foundation this year, it was only 10 yrs. Old at that time. Yet, it was already wonderful, although still in its childhood. It was dwelling then, in the



St. Denis church, on Laurier street, sharing the church with a small and elderly French community. Under the pastoral guidance of Fr. Frank Alvarez and the leadership of dedicated administrators, it was already full of dreams for the future and of energy for the present.

That was the time when I was received into the community. I was not a competee stranger to the members, since I had served as a missionary in Davao during 35 years, where I had know Fr. Frank as a seminarian, many Dominican sisters and a few nurses from the San Pedro Hospital. Immediately, I felt at home with them, happy to share my faith as a priest to many members through seminars on Christian Life and bible Discovery, while receiving from them the testimony of an authentic faith, enjoying the wonderful celebrations of their liturgy, and the beautiful music and songs of their four choirs of adult, youth and children.

I was surprised to discover so many Catechists preparing the children for their First Communion and their Confirmation with great skill and dedication, and the commitment of so many Knights of Columbus in the life and progress of the parish. It was a wonder also to see so many and so fervent altar boys serving in the sanctuary, and so many young girls reading the Scriptures at Mass so perfectly. And to see so many adults participating at Mass every Sunday and contributing so generously to the financial needs and decorations of the church.


So much so that, on eday, the community felt the need to look for a more convenient church to favor the progress of the Mission. Three years ago, the Lord finally heard the prayers of the members and offered to them, the beautiful church of St. Thomas, the Apostle, on st. Laurent Street. Again, all the members made big sacrifices to buy the church and the convent, and to repair them according to the needs and the expectations of the parish.

At 20 yrs. Old, the FCMM has now reached the maturity and the capacity to accomplish its mission of Evangelization in their new country of adoption. Our people here needs badly the example and the testimony of their faith to become again the real Christians they have been in the past. We give thanks to our Filipino brothers and sisters for the testimony they give us of their authentic Christian life. Finally, I am personally grateful to them for the happiness they give me in working with them.
