*The month in which we are urged to grow in our faith and pray for an increase in it, remembering that faith is both a gift from the Lord and a commitment on our part.*

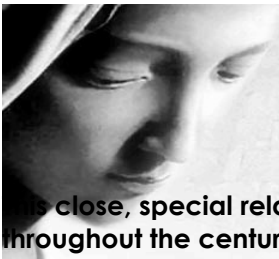
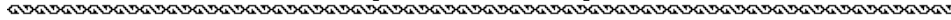

to add, remove or keep a name on the sick list.



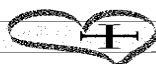
