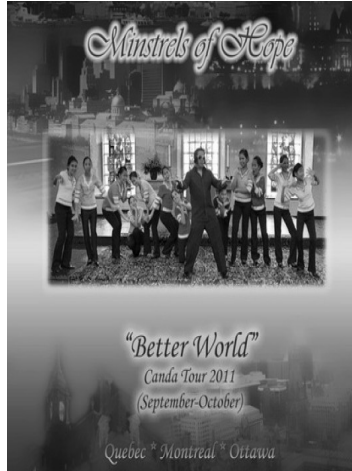

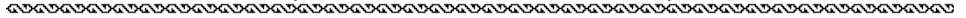

By tradition, the Catholic Church dedicates each month of the year to a certain devotion. The month of October is dedicated to the holy rosary, one of the best known of all Catholic devotions. October includes the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary (October 7). The best way to celebrate the month is, of course, to pray the rosary,



As we begin the month of October –the month of the Rosary – we are reminded of the central place Mary holds in the lives of all of Jesus' disciples. On the cross, Jesus said to Mary: « Woman, here is your son »; he

invited her to extend her maternal care to all those who would follow him.

This close, special relationship between Mary and us has been expressed in various ways throughout the centuries. Among them, praying the Rosary remains one of the pre-eminent and most-recommended devotions. It offers everyone the chance to meditate with Mary on the mysteries of Jesus' life and to join her in praising the Lord. devotion with us in. The following excerpt from the apostolic letter *Rosarium Virginis Mariae*, issued by pope John Paul II on October 16, 2002, conveys the relevance of this devotion for our times.

“The Rosary of the Virgin Mary, which gradually took form in the second millennium under the guidance of the Spirit of God, is a prayer loved by countless Saints and encouraged by the Magisterium. Simple yet profound, it still remains, at the dawn of this third millennium, a prayer of great significance, destined to bring forth a harvest of holiness. It blends easily into the spiritual journey of the Christian life, which, after two thousand years, has lost none of the freshness of its beginnings and feels drawn by the Spirit of God to “set out into the deep” (Jn 14:6), “the goal of human history and the point on which the desires of history and civilization turn”.

The Rosary, though clearly Marian in character, is at heart a Christocentric prayer. the sobriety of its elements, it has all the depth the Gospel message in its entirety, of which it can be said to be a compendium. It is an echo the prayer of Mary, her perennial Magnificat the work of the redemptive Incarnation which began in her virginal womb. With the Rosary, Christian people sits at the school of Mary and led to contemplate the beauty on the face of Christ and to experience the depths of his love. Through the Rosary the faithful receive abundant grace, as though from the very hands of the Mother of the Redeemer.”
