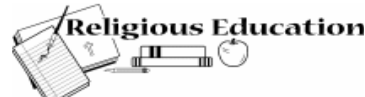

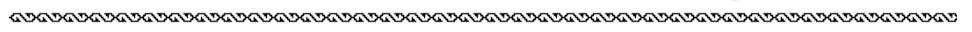


On this Labor Day weekend, we reflect on the dignity of labor. Most of us work because we have to. But, in addition to raising needed money to support our needs we ought to look at work as a vocation to join God who is at work in the world and as an opportunity to serve others. Whether we work in the home or out, whether we are active or retired, we

give thanks to God for health and talent to make a contribution to this world. Saint Augustine, that fourth century saint, once remarked that his "life was his work" and that it had become for him a "troublesome land, a place of too much sweat." His words remind us that our essential life work is our life—creating it in the image of Christ. As we mold and shape our lives into a perfect reflection of Jesus, our tools for the task are the two precepts: "Love God" and "love neighbor." Perfecting one's life is the work that every individual can do and must do. We must make of ourselves a beautiful object—a decent human being. If we do our best day by day to live good lives, God counts it as a productive day. If we have such productive days often enough, and don't give up on ourselves and not brush the hand of God away, then God will judge our lives to be a good work. He is still the creator and is, even now, creating you along with your self-creating. As we begin September and all the activities of parish life begin anew, each of us must take on the discipline of a disciple. 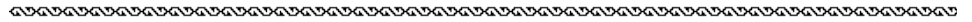
Blessed Pedro Calungsod to be Canonized on October 21, 2012

The Vatican announced that Blessed Pedro Calungsod will be canonized on October 21, 2012. He will be the second Filipino saint.

Pedro Calungsod was a young man born in the Visayas, in Cebu (or maybe in the neighboring islands) in the 17th century. He went as a mission assistant, catechists,

sacristan, to Guam, part of the first Jesuit mission expedition to the Marianas Islands. He was killed "in hatred of the faith" by the same men who were responsible for the martyrdom of the Jesuit mission-superior, Father Diego Luis de San Vitores, declared blessed by Pope John Paul II on October 6 1985 as the Proto-Martyr of the Marianas Islands in the Pacific. Pedro Calungsod's death preceded that of Blessed Diego Luis by a few minutes, on April 2, 1672.

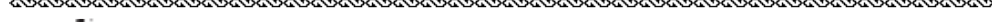
Starting next issue our news bulletin will start featuring a catechism on the life of Bl. Pedro Calungsod.



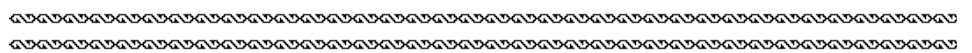
